WHS Music Boosters Meeting  
Minutes

1. Call to Order - Christine called the meeting to order at 7:08pm and wished everyone a happy new year! We will have a special presentation by the assistant principal later this evening.
2. Secretary's Report: Thank you to Stella Mendenhall for taking the December minutes! Minutes were distributed and reviewed. Lorraine Shill moved to accept. Larry Gorlin seconded the motion. The motion was carried. Larry said he didn't have the November minutes for the website - Joyce will email them to him.
3. Treasurer's Report: the November Treasurer's report was distributed and reviewed. The first column represents the month of November activity while the second column represents the year to date. Sharon Collier moved to accept the treasurer's report; Mary Helen Frake-Minar seconded the motion; the report was accepted by unanimous vote.
4. Audit Presentation: Doriana Zutler discussed the audit for the period June 30, 2005 - June 30, 2006. The net balance is acceptable according to Doriana. Difference is \$371 which needs to be reconciled. Sheryl said she has reconciled and will compare notes with Doriana. Doriana said she will show someone how to do the audit report for next year. Festival will be different this year; all performance groups will perform last week in March at Northwood HS; they are still in process of determining who will perform when; concert and festival are combined. Includes Irvine HS, Northwood, WHS and Cal State Fullerton;

Two weeks till finals. No finals in dance color guard but they will practice during that time - Band/orchestra will have finals; they will be tested on material they should know in music.
