**Minutes – August 15, 2006**

1. **Call to Order:** President Christine Chon at 7:20pm. Welcome and introductions by all.
2. **Secretary's Report:** Lynne Bolen presented the minutes of the July 11, 2006 meeting. Sheryl Ho moved to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Kim Pechar. Motion passed.
3. **Treasurer/Financial Secretary's Report:** Sheryl Ho / Janice Hudes – Joslynne Blasdel reported on the June 30, 2006 Treasurer's report prepared by Peggy Tackman. Sheryl Ho asked about the absence of the Income Statement. Peggy had some questions on which accounts to use, so the Income Statement will be presented at the next meeting. James Hamada moved to approve the Balance Sheet portion of the Treasurer's report, seconded by Stella Mendenhall. Motion passed.
4. **Band Director's Report:** Joslynne Blasdel / Brad Harris
  - 2006-07 Budget
    - Entertainment Corps Income \$23,000; Expenses \$33,350; Shortage of \$10,350 divided by 200 members = \$51.75 per student to fundraise.
    - Percussion Ensemble Income \$4,000; Expenses \$8,773; Shortage of \$4,773 divided by 18 members = \$265.17 per student to fundraise.
    - Orchestra Income \$3,350; Expenses \$7,360; Shortage of \$4,010 divided by 90 members = \$44.56 per student to fundraise.
    - Dance Team Income \$12,550; Expenses \$19,340; Shortage of \$6,790 divided by 16 members = \$424.38 per student to fundraise. The Car Wash income was inadvertently omitted and will be added to the Budget.
    - Color Guard Income \$16,100; Expenses \$15,865.
    - Department Income – Bingo \$15,000 to be divided by shares for those volunteering to work bingo. Student accounts will be credited.
    - Entertainment Corps Camp Income \$45,360; Expenses \$45,360.
    - Mary Helen Frake-Minar made a motion to approve the Budget, with the exception of the modification to the Car Wash income for Dance, seconded by Larry Gorlin. Motion passed.
  - The District will pay for buses to home football games.
  - All girls will need to buy concert dresses this year for \$80.
  - The Handbook will be split into two: Entertainment Corps and Orchestra.

- VP Dance: Terri Inspektor – At camp last week, 4 girls made it into the top 10 out of 200. The Dance Team received the award for Hardest Working Team at camp.
- VP Orchestra: Karyn Rashoff – absent.
- Auditor: Doriana Zutler – absent.
- Communications: Stella Mendenhall – waiting to get data from Debbie Gardner.
